## Limited 10-Year Warranty

FreeStyle™ is manufactured to provide a durable and long-lasting floor covering under a range of temperature and exposure conditions and is backed by a 10-Year Limited Warranty against wear. Ask your FreeStyle™ dealer for more details on this Limited 10-Year Warranty.

## Installation

FreeStyle™ is a 18.5" x 18.5" (2.38 sq. ft./tile) inter-locking floor tile. A plastic tipped mallet or deadhead hammer should be used for joining these products. Tiles can be cut using a utility knife, vinyl-tile cutter, or jig saw. FreeStyle™ is a free-lay system and does not require the use of adhesives. FreeStyle™ may be installed over concrete, wood, asbestos tile, rubber, vinyl, composite tiles, and other standard floors. A 3/8" gap around the perimeter should be left to allow for expansion and contraction. For more detailed instructions, consult the FreeStyle™ Installation Guide.

## Regular Maintenance

FreeStyle™ is easy to clean and maintain. The tiles can be cleaned with standard neutral cleansers or other acceptable cleansers. The tiles can be cleaned by hand using a mop or sponge. A power scrubber or buffer can also be used to clean particularly tough stains and soiling.

## Architectural Specifications


All floors shown in the Finish Schedule or listed in this specification shall be FreeStyle™ Resilient Flooring, manufactured by SelecTech, Inc. Avon, MA. The product shall be an interlocking floor tile and be available in 18.5" x 18.5" squares (nominal) and with a thickness of 0.375 inches. The product shall offer a 10-Year Limited Warranty against wear as detailed in the FreeStyle™ Warranty brochure. The tiles shall be installed as a free-lay product without adhesives. Installation shall be as recommended in the FreeStyle™ Installation Guide.
